Statement on the PPWR (Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation) for J.J. Darboven brands.

Dear Sir or Madam,

J.J. Darboven actively monitors the requirements of the EU Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (PPWR) and has initiated the necessary measures to implement the relevant provisions.

As the manufacturer and/or distributor of our products, we are responsible for complying with the PPWR requirements applicable to us. Accordingly, we ensure that our packaging and packaging materials comply with all applicable legal requirements.

Based on our current knowledge, we do not knowingly use intentionally added PFAS (per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances) or intentionally added heavy metals in our packaging. Furthermore, the applicable legal limit values for PFAS and heavy metals are complied with. The necessary assessments and coordination with our suppliers are carried out on an ongoing basis as part of our compliance processes.

We maintain close communication with our packaging and raw material suppliers and obtain the necessary information throughout the supply chain. Compliance with the PPWR requirements is an integral part of our supplier and quality management systems.

As a general principle, J.J. Darboven does not intend to provide technical documentation or declarations of conformity within the meaning of the PPWR. We independently fulfil the legal obligations relevant to our role within the supply chain and ensure the compliance of our products and packaging in accordance with the applicable regulatory requirements.

Should additional legal requirements or information obligations become relevant for our products in the future, we will implement them accordingly and support our customers to the extent required.
